- Located adjacent to Happy Jack Landfill on City owned land currently used for grazing

- The facility will produce up to 30 megawatts of renewable energy from fourteen wind turbines; that's approximately 100,000,000 kilowatt-hours of electricity per year – enough for 12,000 average homes!
- No public funding was used for its development
- It will deliver 100% of its clean energy to the Cheyenne region
- Wind turbine tower height is 275 feet; height to blade tip is 403 feet
- It will generate energy approximately 70-80% of the time
- Safe, reliable, fixed price energy made in the USA!
